1) Would you like to specify the location of the plant in the territory of Lubero to allow us to properly calculate the cost of transport and the remains?	On the road N2, close to "Permanence ACUP Lubero", in this city center.
2) The type of biscuit desired.	We want to make small biscuits (of the Cremica type), fortified biscuits. A sample explanation is at: https://docs.wfp.org/api/documents/WFP-0000111103/download/
3) The type of packaging desired.	Small packages with 300 grams of biscuit per package. With the possibility of changing the grammage if necessary. The packages will be packaging for dry storage, of the plastic type.
4) Do you have a backup system in case of power outage?	No, we don't have a generator. But the region has electricity from Virunga Energies, so we don't need a backup system.
5) Could you please send photos of the final sample of biscuits you would like to produce? This is very important to clarify the technical offer.	We want to produce small biscuits (of the Cremica type), i.e. fortified biscuits. 6) In order to be able to offer the metal structure, could you indicate the dimensions of the place designated for the installation?	The production line will be in a 400m ² (extendable to 600m ² if required) 20mx20m shed with 4m height.
7) Please provide information on the foundation on which the structures will be placed.	It will be a concrete slab several centimetres thick, resistant to the vibrations of the various machines on the line.
8) Is there an electrical connection? If not, should we make a proposal for the connection as well?	We have a stable electrical connection, no need to add a generator.
